Notice of Dues Payment Deadline

All dues payments must be paid and received in the office by February 10th. Please note that the office will close at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, February 10th.

Payments received after February 10th will be considered late. Effective February 11th, a \$25 late fee will apply.

This applies to charges processed in the office ONLY:

Effective January 1st, 2026 - Credit Card Fee

*3.6% bank fee per transaction for credit card use. Example:

\$485.00 x 3.6% = \$17.46

\$545.00 x 3.6% = \$19.62

*Any bank, payment processing, or transaction fees incurred as a result of a member's payment will be charged to the individual member making the payment. This ensures that membership funds are used fully for supporting the club and not reduced by banking costs.
